Kay and I went to the Philippines in January of 2011. I taught Bible classes to 16 students for 12 weeks. Ezra, Esther, and Nehemiah were used in a study entitled "The Captivity and Restoration of Israel". English as a Second Language was provided to 15-25 students weekly in San Narciso. Regular opportunities were provided for me to preach in Olongapo and San Narciso churches.

The upper floor of the San Narciso church was finished this year and the apartment began. Also Pastor Art began work on the steel trusses for the roof. The building is about 80% finished.

Another highlight of the 2011 trip was a visit to the Aeta tribal people. We were able to provide rice, flip-flops, clothing and a meal of spaghetti for over 100 tribal people.

Pastor Art had a leadership seminar for the Tribal pastors, their wives and workers. More than 40, attended in the Olongapo church. I taught on Leadership in the Family. We had an awesome time with the Lord for 3 days. Many saw movies for the first time and had more food than they had ever seen. What a blessing for these, poorest of the poor.

With the Lord's provision the rice feeding and scholarship programs continue. We still have 3 in college. Shipped 12 boxes and we still have 6 to ship.

This September we joined with Youth with a Mission, University of the Nations, located in Kona Hawaii. I joined the staff of the English Language and Culture School led by Paul and Norma Olsen. I assisted in teaching English as a Second Language to students from 5 different countries, Norway, China, Korea, Brazil and Switzerland. Kay worked in hospitality and the office of ELC.

What a privilege to teach ESL using the Bible as the text. We had one young man from China accept the Lord. He also celebrated his first Thanksgiving and Christmas with us. How exciting to see God work in the young people. The University had its largest ever enrollment of over 500 students. You can only imagine the Holy Spirit energized worship times with these young people. I learned many new teaching methods and techniques which I will use in the Philippines Bible classes. Also I will be able to use all the new computer hardware and web sites to great advantage. However this brings up the need for updated equipment. Pray for us an over head projector (computer type) and a higher speed computer with a dedicated video card. These could cost between \$1200.00 and \$1500.00 and could be used both in ESL and the Bible Classes.

We returned home again on December 14th to spend Christmas with family.

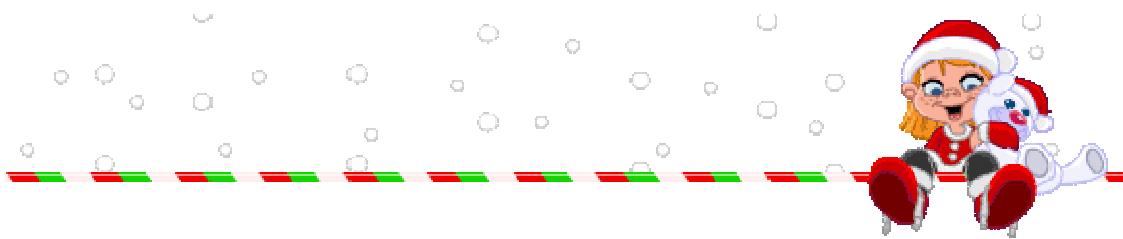
We give God the glory for He alone is worthy. He has blessed us beyond what we can ask or
