These were the exciting words Matt heard from Pastor Moyo a week after he and a group of 2nd year students spent 2 weeks in the Village of **Kang**, in the Kalahari desert, as part of a **missions practicum course** at Assembly Bible College.

As part of the missions course, the students take a 2 week trip to a remote village to encourage the Pastor, the church, and minister in the area.

The team broke into groups and preached in clinics, outside of bars, and ministered in three remote bush villages nearby, seeing many people make **decisions to follow Christ**. The students then connected the new believers with the Kang church and other believers for discipleship and training.

As an act of service, the students prepared and painted the Kang AG church, as it had never been painted before.

Another exciting ministry opportunity was to host the **Acts in Africa (AIA)** team. The tremendous ministry time encouraged believers to receive the Spirit's power to be a witness and to train leaders in scriptural Spirit baptism. The vision of AIA and the Assemblies of God in Africa is to see 10 million believers baptized in the Holy Spirit by 2020. It was a great kick-off in Botswana as many were baptized in the Holy Spirit at the powerful altar times during the week.
