Community Leadership Training Center is a new ministry training center in Kampala. The current project phase is to complete the walls before roofing. The need is \$7,000, of which \$800 has already been funded. The team will spend 2 days working on the construction of this phase of the building working with:

- 10,000 clay bricks
- 21 tons of sand
- 7 tones of stone aggregate
- 105 bags of cement
- 104 assorted iron bars
- Cement ventilators
- 1 roll binding wire
- 1 roll hoop iron
- Assorted wire nails
- Labor

The “Buy A Brick” campaign is to raise money specifically for the Training Center in Kampala. One dollar purchases one brick.

In Arua, Martin and Elizabeth are working to build a new school. They were blessed with acquisition of a piece of property. They are working to prepare the land for a foundation.

The first phase of the School Project in Arua will cost \$2,500 for:

- Site preparation
- Digging of the foundation
- Building of the foundation
- Stones
- Cement
- Sand
- Bricks
- Labor
